**WARNING NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

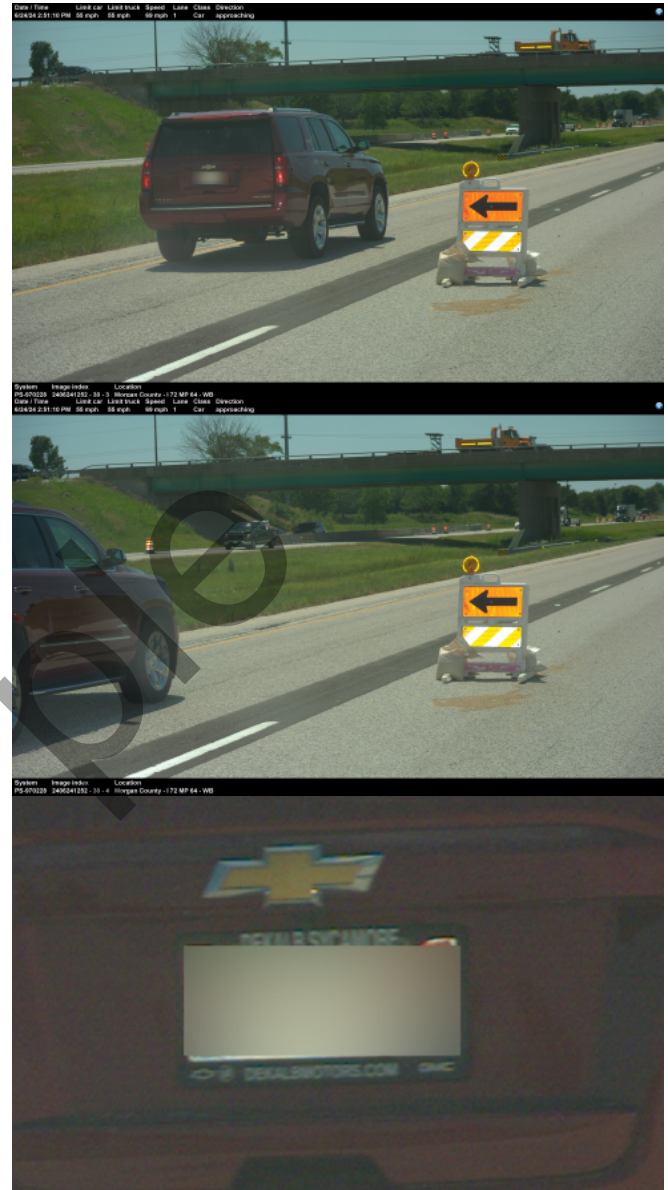

The Indiana Department of Transportation has implemented a program to improve worksite safety for motorists and workers. Authorized by IC 8-23-32, the Worksite Speed Control Program uses speed timing devices and image capture equipment to identify vehicles traveling 11 MPH or more in excess of the posted speed limit in an active worksite.

This is your first violation and carries no financial penalty. A second violation under this section will result in a \$75 penalty. A third, and all subsequent violations, will carry a \$150 penalty for each occurrence.

**YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO RESPOND TO THIS NOTICE. Failure to contest this warning notice of violation is considered an admission of liability and may be used to determine subsequent violations and assessed fines.**

Failure to contest liability within 15 days will result in the loss of your right to a hearing. Instructions to contest liability are included on the back of this violation.

# Worksite Speed Control Program



A vehicle, registered or leased to you, was photographed by a worksite speed control system. Superimposed on each photograph is the date, time, location and speed of the vehicle when the violation occurred.

As the registered owner of the vehicle described in this Notice, you are legally responsible for this violation.

This violation is not considered a moving violation. It is a civil penalty holding the registered owner or lessee responsible for the violation (similar to a parking ticket). **NO POINTS CAN BE ASSESSED FOR THIS VIOLATION AND IT WILL NOT APPEAR ON YOUR DRIVING RECORD.**

## **HOW TO CONTEST VIOLATION**

This notice of violation is considered an agency action. Should you wish to request a hearing to review the agency action and contest this violation, you may do so through the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings by following one of the three options below. Failure to request a hearing within 15 days will result in the loss of your right to a hearing:

- 1) Go online to [www.in.gov/oalp](http://www.in.gov/oalp) and complete a Petition for Review;
- 2) Mail your request to the Office of Administrative Law Proceedings located at 100 N. Senate Avenue Suite N802, Indianapolis, IN 46204; or
- 3) Personally appear at the Office of Administrative Law Proceedings located at 100 N. Senate Avenue Suite N802, Indianapolis, IN 46204 to file Petition for Review.

You will need this document to complete your request.
